

A CRAFT PROJECT TO *Light the Dark*

*"The light shines in the darkness,
and the darkness has not overcome it"*
John 1:1-5

Materials

Glass jars

Sticker-backed alphabet letters

Star stickers, or other shapes

(Alternatively hand cut contact/sticky-back paper can be used)

Spray paint (black, grey or gold recommended)

Battery operated string lights, or Christmas lights (and batteries).

Instructions

Step One: Use the sticker lettering or an alternative to create a 'light in the dark' message on your light lantern such as:

The light shines in the dark.

Light overcomes.

Be light.

Light the dark.

Shine Light.

Light Shines.



Step Two: Cover the remaining space on the jar with star stickers or similar motives. As many as will fit.

Step Three: Read the instructions on your spray paint and follow them to completely cover your jar. Allow to dry.

Step Four: Once the paint is dry, gently peel off the stickers.

Step Five: Place the string lights inside, turn them on and light the dark!
